Pastor's Corner

It's been a sweet week for me, personally. My wife's working in NM at Ghost Ranch, and while I love and miss her, I do enjoy a sweet dynamic: those moments when kids have to deal with me because their first choice is out of town! I can't braid hair, but I can cough up some posterboard for a project, make a school lunch, and deal with a kid's first traffic ticket! It makes me appreciate her more, of course. I'm reminded of the image of the home and family as a "domestic church." Regardless of who you grew up with, or live with now, our homes are places of ministry and discipleship: the wins and the losses, the vices and the virtues. Often, I think of psalms or hymns when my mind goes in this direction. But this week I've had a secular song stuck in my head all week. Maybe you've heard Crowded Table, by Highwomen. Both the song and video (<https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=ZPfl8zBWub4>) bear witness to both the messiness and the beauty of community life, helping each other, and being that delightful human mix of wonderful and broken at the same time. Sometimes it gets crowded or awkward around our table: homework, clutter, projects; they meet both our bad habits and our best selves. Hard feelings meet reconciliation; we are nourished, and grace wins.

Same with our altar at Holy Trinity. Sometimes we have awkward moments of traffic, or waiting for a spot to receive, or waiting to prepare a chalice or get more hosts.... Then we make ourselves small—remembering Jesus's words to become like a child—as we kneel to receive his blessing, or even receive Him in bread and wine.

Rally Day is coming this Sunday. I hope you will come with an open heart and be ready to see where God is calling you. Maybe you are overcommitted and just need to be fed, to receive? Take a class, commit to a time of prayer! Maybe you are being called to give? Sign up to volunteer! There is a place for you, no matter how crowded the table feels! What young people in your life do you know? Is now the time to get them launched into our new Alpha group on Wednesdays at 7:00pm?

Finally, this Sunday we hear one of the weirdest parables. Is this crazy story really the Gospel? How many masters do you think have, anyway? Come join us and pray for me!
